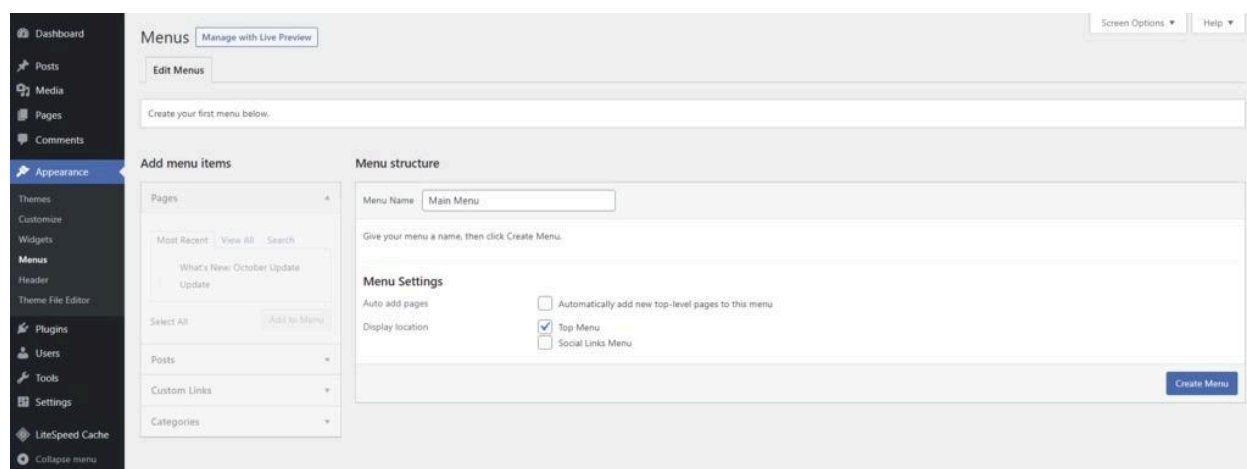


Adding a Page to a Menu/Navigation in WordPress

WordPress allows you to easily manage your website's menu/navigation from the admin dashboard. Follow these steps to add it as a menu/navigation:

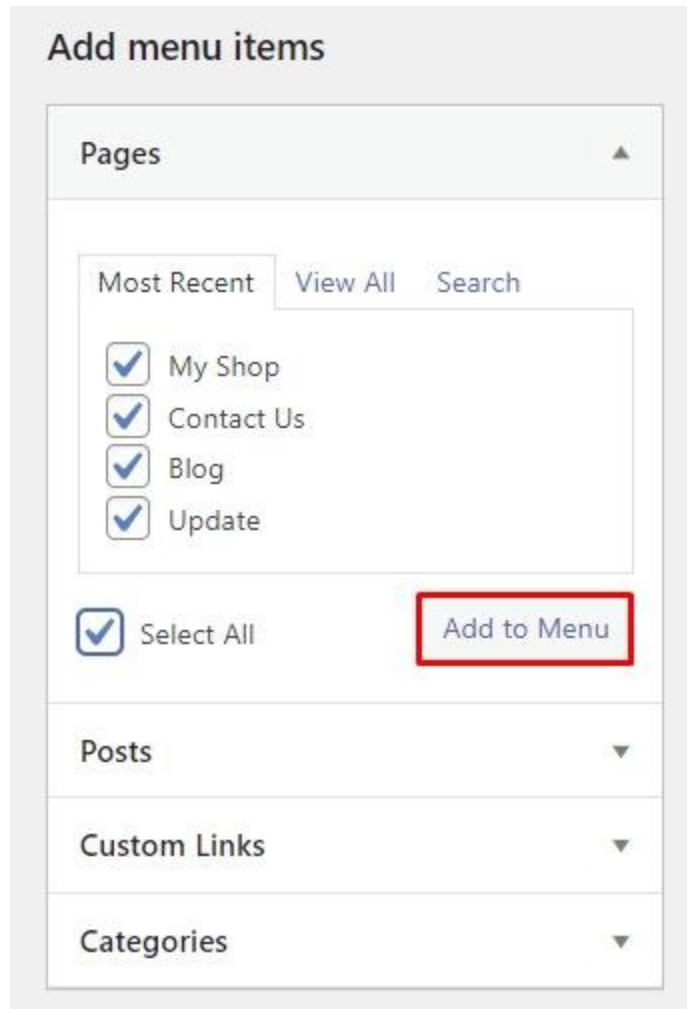
1. Create a New Menu

- From the WordPress dashboard, go to **Appearance** → **Menus**.
- In the **Menu Name** section, give your menu a name and check the box for **Top Menu** (or another menu location, if preferred).
- Click **Create Menu**. Repeat this step if you want to create more pages for the menu.



2. Add Pages to Your Menu

- In the **Add menu items** section, under **Pages**, check the box next to the pages you want to add.
- Click **Add to Menu** to include them in your new menu.



3. Reorder and Organise Menu Items

- You can easily reorder the menu items by **dragging and dropping** them.
- To create a sub-menu, drag a menu item slightly to the right below a parent menu item.
- Once satisfied with the arrangement, click **Save Menu**.
